PROTECT YOUR RIDE

Use Common Sense

Vehicle owners should always remove keys from the ignition, lock doors, completely roll up windows, and park in well-lit areas.

Visible and Audible Warning Devices

Aftermarket alarms are available for all makes and models of cars. Visual devices include column collars, steering wheel locks, and brake pedal locks. Use theft deterrent decals and etch windows with identification markers.

Immobilizing devices

Immobilizing devices prevent thieves from bypassing the ignition and hot-wiring the vehicle. Some examples are smart keys; fuse cut-offs; kill switches; starter, ignition, and fuel pump disablers; and wireless ignition authentication.

Tracking devices

Tracking devices are very effective in helping authorities recover stolen vehicles. Some systems combine GPS and wireless technologies to allow remote monitoring of a vehicle. If the vehicle is moved, the system will alert the owner, and the vehicle can be tracked via computer.
