JJG 080-002	Depositions used in court	A Deposition is the testimony of someone who may know about a case, taken under oath and committed to writing and authenticated by a court reporter. JJG 080-003	Seal Depositions not used in case	A Deposition is the testimony of someone who may know about a case, taken under oath and committed to writing and authenticated by a court reporter.
